

## NSPCC keeping Children Safer Conference in London

On the 21<sup>st</sup> and the 22<sup>nd</sup> June Service Six Staff, Emma Campion, Hayley Brown and Katie Marsh attended the NSPCC keeping children safer conference in London.

**Day 1:** Sara Rowbotham, The Sexual Health worker from the Rochdale case, whose warnings about the exploitation of young girls in the area repeatedly fell on deaf ears, shared her experiences. The message we took away from this was to persevere to achieve the best suitable and safe outcome for the young person to meet their needs. This is also in line with Service Six ethos.

**Day 2:** James Rhodes, spoke about his moving story of his survival after experiencing abuse by his gym teacher from the age of 5 to 10. James spoke passionately about his battles within the mental health service and how it has impacted his life. James found that music was his saviour and is now a classical musician. James' message to us all was to encourage open conversations around this subject. Service Six always create opportunities to enable young people to have an open and safe conversation about issues affecting them.
